It describes how Jennie, who has autism and learning difficulties and is the daughter of co-author Suzie Franklin, was supported through the transition from school to independent living using evidence-based planning tools. The other co-author is Helen Sanderson, an expert in person-centred thinking and planning; together, the writers seek to demonstrate how this approach works in practice, including dealing with Individual Service Funds and personal budgets.
